## But what if they can't hear the alarm?

For our deaf and hard-of-hearing residents, we now offer free alarm devices that react to the sound of the actual smoke alarm with loud sounds, flashing lights and by vibrating the person's bed.

## To qualify for the program you must...

- A. Be a Kansas resident over the age of four.
- B. Be certified as deaf or hard-of-hearing by a health care professional, such as a physician, audiologist, Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner, nurse practitioner, physician's assistant, speech pathologist, or vocational rehabilitation counselor.
- C. NOT live in an institutional facility (nursing home, hospital, etc.)



Once approved by our office, the alarms will be delivered to your home by a participating fire department or OSFM representative who can ensure the alarms are set-up properly and you know how to use them.
